Detective Luken served as a law enforcement officer for just under 40 years. He spent 25½ years with the Cincinnati Police Department, until he was promoted to detective. He spent 13 years investigating robberies, burglaries, breaking & entering, thefts and credit card fraud investigations in the downtown area of Cincinnati. He also served 16 years as a tactical member and negotiator with the Cincinnati Police SWAT Team.

He was assigned to the Cincinnati Police Pharmaceutical Diversion Squad during the last 4½ years of his career with the Cincinnati Police Division Pharmaceutical Diversion Squad conducting investigations involving crimes associated with the diversion of pharmaceutical drug crimes and diversion by health professionals.

After retiring from the Cincinnati Police Department, Detective Luken accepted a new position early in 2001 as a detective with the Greater Warren County Drug Task Force in southwestern Ohio. His primary responsibilities involved conducting investigation involving pharmaceutical drug crimes and diversion by health professionals.

Detective Luken has devoted the last 19 years of his career conducting pharmaceutical drug diversion crimes and has trained numerous individuals in the field of pharmaceutical drug crimes. He has also conducted hundreds of training presentations for law enforcement and health professionals. He has also received numerous awards during his 40 year law enforcement career.
