Marsha Stanton is a registered nurse with a bachelor's degree in Health Services Administration and Education, a Master of Science in Health & Human Services, and a PhD in Health Services Administration and Education. She has served as the Executive Director of Medical Affairs for several pharmaceutical manufacturing companies focusing on Program Development/Education/Advocacy and Alliance Development. Her career has spanned clinical practice, program development, health professional education, and publication planning and alliance development.

She is nationally known for her work in the area of pain management and has published and presented in this field on many occasions. She has served in leadership roles with the American Society for Pain Management Nursing, Intermountain West Pain Management Nurses, American Academy of Pain Management, American Academy of Pain Medicine and Pain Management Education Consultants.
